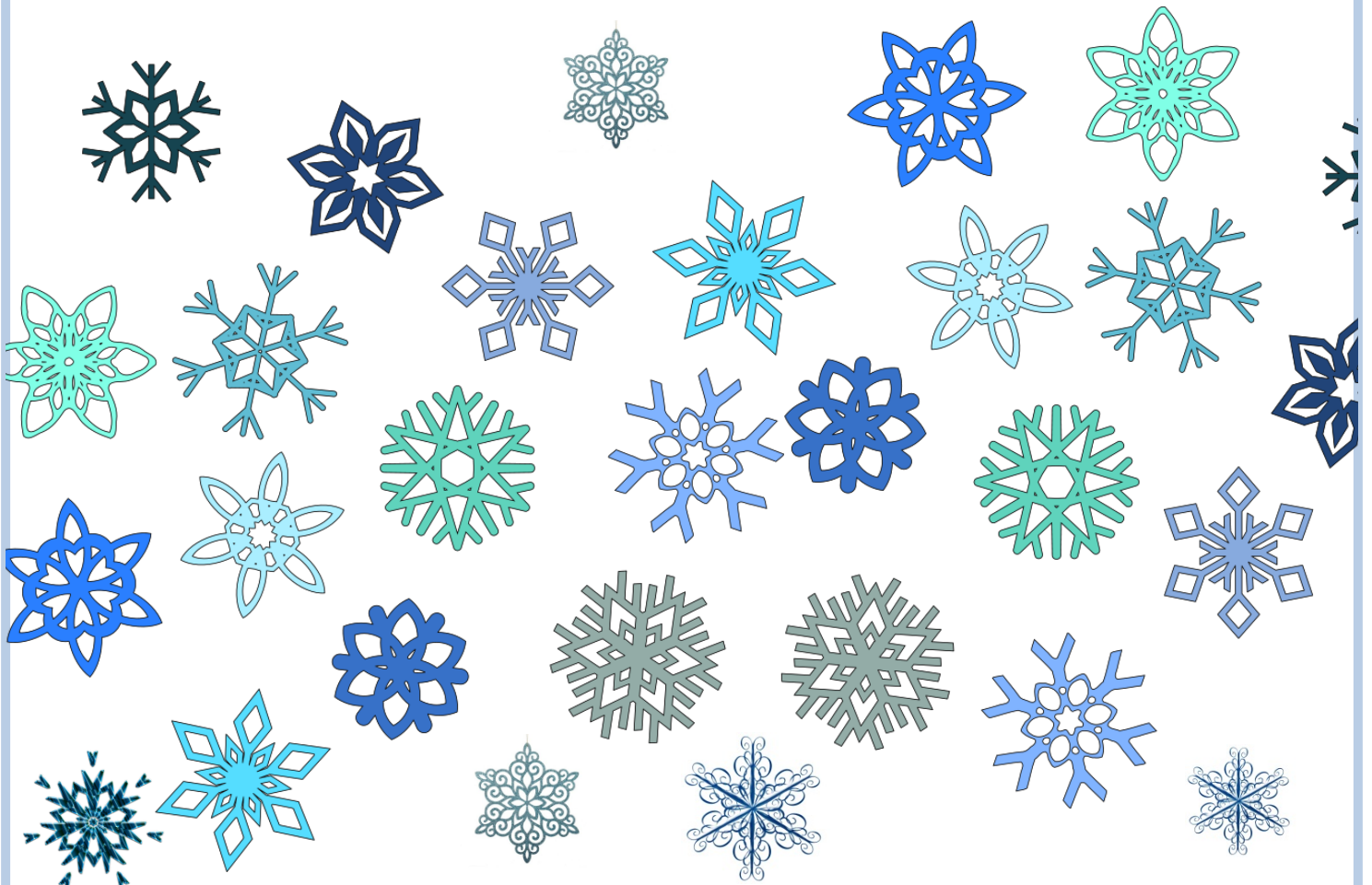

Please only donate things that can be played with in bed

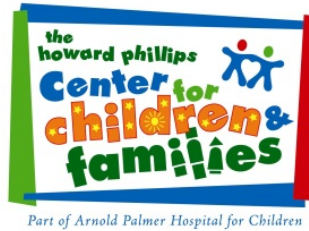
(no outdoor toys /very large items please)

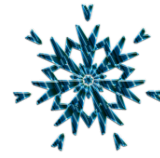
